

- Encourages and incents people to participate in revitalization and preservation efforts
- Protects cultural, historic and environmental resources
- Assists with revitalization of declining neighborhoods
- Provides resources to assist people with rehabilitation of their properties
- Maintains existing built and natural public infrastructure
- Provides and maintains greenways, open space, and agricultural lands
- Provides programs to assist with managing traffic, lowering crime, reducing vandalism, and eradicating graffiti
- Assist with the identification and mobilization of funding sources for preservation of historic properties
- Maintains and enhances streets, greenways, and parks to promote active, clean, safe and livable spaces

- Organizes neighborhoods and develops leaders to work within and across neighborhoods
- Connects people with one another and fosters relationship building
- Celebrates the diversity of all people, ideas and values, and promotes cultural understanding
- Provides bilingual services that help navigate systems
- Provides cultural, recreational, educational, and social opportunities for all residents
- Engages all segments of the community in efforts to improve the quality of life within their neighborhoods
- Ensures City programs and services are culturally competent and accessible to all
- Includes art in public parks/greenways
- Provides opportunities for all people to participate in government decisions, processes, and activities
- Partners with community groups and organizations to provide services
- Connects people with services that help to meet their needs
- Encourages a mix of housing to provide diversity within neighborhoods
- Promotes citizens participation and involvement in their neighborhoods
 - Builds neighborhood capacity to identify and solve problems and resolve conflict
 - Provides support for neighborhood events that foster relationship building and create a sense of community
 - Plans and designs neighborhoods that provide physical opportunities to foster neighbor to neighbor interactions



- Promotes fair housing practices and provides fair housing education
- Ensures the community has a mix of housing opportunities to accommodate people of all income levels
- Ensures compliance with minimum housing construction and maintenance standards
- Educates landlords and tenants and provides mediation services for conflict resolution
- Provides programs/services to ensure safe and decent housing for all
- Connects transient, homeless, and low income people with resources to ensure basic housing needs are met
- Provides prevention and intervention services/programs for individuals/families faced with critical housing needs
- Administers a variety of programs with funding sources to assist low income residents achieve home ownership
- Provide resources/assistance to rehabilitate existing housing for low income renters and/or homeowners

- Protects health and safety of citizens
- Ensures minimum construction standards are met
- Enforces codes, rules and regulations
- Educates residents regarding City codes, rules, regulations and services
- Engages residents and facilitates neighborhood problem solving
- Partners with residents to develop programs/solutions to address neighborhood safety and social issues
- Responds quickly and appropriately to citizen complaints of code violations
- Provides programs/services to ensure safe and decent housing for all
- Assists with the preservation, repair and maintenance of existing housing stock
- Provides access to funding that maintains and preserves local historic resources

- Plans streets systems that support all modes of travel
- Designs and builds public infrastructure/facilities to minimize impacts on the environment, ensure durability, minimize maintenance costs, conserve resources, and promote healthy landscapes
- Locates and builds greenways to link schools, parks and other public infrastructure for optimum storm water maintenance, alternative transportation utilization, social interaction, and recreational opportunity
- Protects and interprets historical, environmental, and cultural spaces for public enjoyment and education
- Ensures compliance with health, safety, and environmental regulations
- Utilizes active community environment principles to promote healthy lifestyles, social interaction, and sustainability
- Engages the public in the design of parks and greenways to address needs and create a sense of ownership
- Addresses safety issues and reduces the impact of criminal activity through design techniques and features
- Maintains and enhances streets, greenways, and parks to promote active, clean, safe and livable spaces
- Addresses access and service barriers for individuals and neighborhoods
- Provides Neighborhood Improvement Grants to encourage participation in the construction, maintenance and enjoyment of public spaces and activities that promote pride in neighborhoods
- Ensures and promotes quick removal of graffiti and trash
