

"Chick" Clark Kids' Fishing Program Rules

1. Only children 15 years or younger are allowed to fish in the lake.
2. Only one personally attended rod per actively fishing child is allowed.
3. Actively fishing children should be near the fishing rod at all times when angling.
4. Children 15 years and younger do not need a state fishing license and may take a full daily bag limit.
5. Anglers must comply with all applicable Colorado Division of Wildlife regulations. All persons present in the park must comply with City of Longmont rules and regulations.
6. Live bait is allowed.
7. Minimum size and possession limits for species kept must comply with Colorado Division of Wildlife regulations.
8. Anglers are encouraged to consider others and only take those fish they will consume within the week.
9. Parents are encouraged to accompany and assist children fishing but should not actively engage in fishing.
10. All parents are responsible and must exercise caution and maintain the safe conduct of their children while fishing.
11. Fishing courtesy encourages maintaining a minimum of 50' between other parties fishing.
12. Park Hours: 1 hour before sunrise to 1 hour after sunset.
13. Dogs must be leashed at all times and are not permitted in the water.
14. Deposit all trash and litter in designated trash receptacles.
15. No glass or alcohol permitted.
