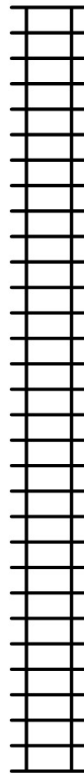


LONGMONT DIAGONAL RAIL FEASIBILITY STUDY

The study area falls within Boulder County and includes the cities of Boulder and Longmont and the community of Niwot.

In exploring the potential for rail service along the Diagonal, the study will address issues such as travel demand, potential economic and environmental impacts, land use, and costs. It will also identify candidate stations, parking areas, and conceptual station designs. 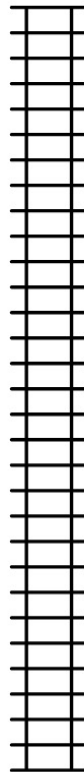
