



## MINIMAL INDUSTRIAL DISCHARGE APPLICATION

This application is a formal request to obtain permission to discharge wastes generated only from operations defined by the CDPHE as minimal industrial discharges to the City of Longmont MS4 (Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System) under Chapter 14.26 of the Longmont Municipal Code. Based on the information provided in this application, the City of Longmont will determine if the applicant meets the requirements to obtain permission to discharge.

Permission to discharge shall be valid until December 31st of this year or until the date of expiration of Certification under the General Minimal Industrial Discharge Permit issued by the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, whichever comes first.

- Representative discharge samples were collected and analyzed by EPA approved methods. The analytical report is attached.
- The City of Longmont will be notified by the Permittee of any violations to the terms or conditions of the state MINDI (COG-600000) permit.

## SECTION D – CERTIFICATION STATEMENT

I wish to apply for a permit to discharge heat transfer equipment cleaning wastewater to various locations of the City of Longmont's MS4 under Chapter 14.26 of the City of Longmont Municipal Code. I understand that, if approved, the permission to discharge will be valid for 90 days or until the date of expiration of the Certification under the General Minimal Industrial Discharge Permit (CDPS COG-600000) issued by the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, whichever comes first. The City of Longmont requires a renewal application and proof of certification dates under CDPS COG-600000 to extend the expiration date.

I certify under penalty of law that this document and all attachments were prepared under my direction or supervision in accordance with a system designed to assure that qualified personnel properly gathered and evaluate the information submitted. Based on my inquiry of the person or persons who manage the system, or those persons directly responsible for gathering the information, the information is, to the best of my knowledge and belief, true, accurate, and complete.
