

Continuing Colored Pencil Drawing

Prerequisite: Colored Pencil Drawing of plants and flowers

This is a continuing exploration with colored pencil drawing of botanicals. We will explore the details of drawing fuzzy plants or hair, wet plants and water drops. We will explore drawing other types of objects such as glass, wood, and feathers so that when you want to put props in your botanical illustrations you will be prepared. How about a glass vase full of flowers, a bird in a gourd birdhouse, or a glass jar of dried spices on a wood spice rack, these are some of the scenarios you might want to draw. We will draw from still life's and photos.

Supplies:

A set of 24 (or more) Prismacolor Premier colored pencils

a white plastic eraser

a pad of 9" x 12" smooth Bristol board

a Prismacolor colorless blender pencil (Office Depot has these the cheapest)
