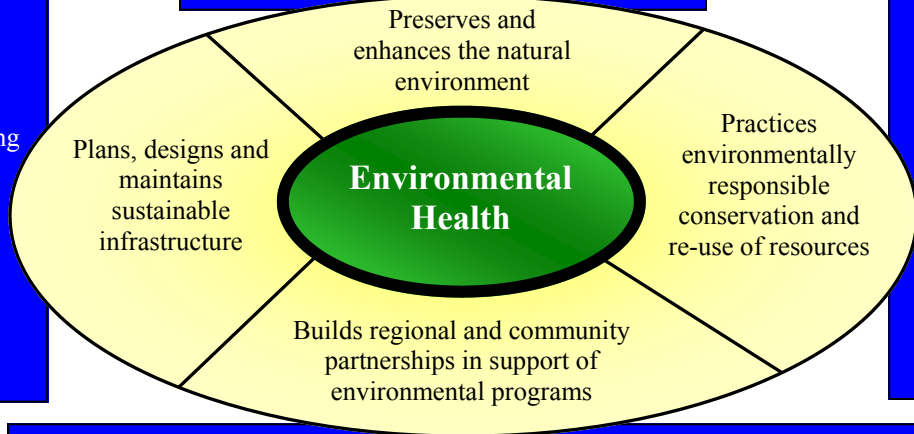


- Update, revise and enforce construction SOPs and design specs
